



HOW TO GET TO THE AIRPORT FROM THE HOTEL:

OPTION 1

Metro: (Best option)

- At Cuzco station (nearest Metro station to hotel), take the Line 10 to Puerta del Sur and get off at Nuevos Ministerios station.
- 2. Transfer at Nuevos Ministerios to Line 8. (to Airport).
- 3. Go out at T1, T2 and T3 stop or at T4 station, depending on your flight.

OPTION 2

Taxi: can be taken directly from the hotel and it's a fixed cost of 30€




HOW TO GET FROM CUZCO TO HOTEL SENATOR CASTELLANA

BEST OPTION:

- Metro from T1, T2, T3 & T4 Airport Terminals to Cuzco station, which is the nearest Metro station to hotel.
- Take the metro Line 8 at the Airport T1-T2-T3 station or at the Airport T4 station (depending to which terminal you arrived) to Nuevos Ministerios (last stop).
- Transfer at Nuevos Ministerios to Line 10 (direction to Tres Olivos).
- Stop in Cuzco station and take the exit: Po de la Castellana impares, then walk 6-7 minutes to the Hotel.









LEISURE TIME OPPORTUNITIES

Museo Nacional Del Prado: Its walls are lined with masterpieces from the Spanish, Italian and Flemish schools, including Velázquez, El Greco or Goya. Its collection comprises 8,600 paintings and over 700 sculptures.

METRO: Stop at Atocha (Line 1)

Museo Nacional Centro de Arte Reina Sofía: The National Musem of 20th Century art is named after Queen Sofía and includes excellent collections of most famous Spanish artists including pieces from Pablo Picasso and Salvador Dali.

Parque de El Retiro : Is one of the largest parks in Madrid and features many different activities. From free concerts on Sundays to multiple exercise groups or rowing a boat on the park lake.

LEISURE TIME OPPORTUNITIES

Gran Via: commonly known as the "Spanish Broadway" is the main street of the city where you can find many theatres, cinemas and shops. It has an exciting atmosphere 24/7.

METRO: Stop at Gran via or Callao (Lines 5 – 3)

Plaza Mayor: The principal square of Madrid host some of greatest bars and restaurants in Madrid. The Plazas vibrant atmosphere and its traditional architecture is a must see!

METRO: Stop at Sol (Line 1 - 2 - 3)

El Rastro: Is an outside market held every Sunday in Madrid between 9am and 3pm. A great chance to explore a market from hundreds of different sellers with many Spanish specialties and antiques.

METRO: Stop at La Latina (Line 5)

<u>La Latina</u>: the lively and colorful area of La Latina is a maze of narrow lanes filled with tapas bars and cantinas.

LEISURE TIME OPPORTUNITIES

Templo de Debod: Is an Egyptian temple dating back to the 2nd century BC.
The temple was donated to Spain by the Egyptian government to save it from floods following the construction of the great Aswan Dam.

METRO: Stop at Plaza España (Line 10 – 3)

Sol: Is one of Madrid's most relevant squares. Surrounded by many historical streets, such as Calle Mayor, Calle Arenal, Calle Alcalá and Calle Preciados, which converge here. Aslo, it contains several of the city's best known landmarks such as the famous clock at Casa de Correos, the plaque marking Kilometro Cero and the statue of the bear an the Strawberry Tree.

METRO: Stop at Sol (Line 1-2-3)

Palacio Real Y Catedral de La Almudena: Home to the Kings of Spain from Charles III to Alfonso XIII, Madrid's Royal Palace takes us on a journey through the history of Spain. Though it is no longer the royal family's home, it continues to be their official residence which can be visited.

METRO: Stop at Opera (Line 5 – 2)

METRO

Is open daily from 6:00 a.m. to 1:30 a.m., although some exits have limited opening times. Service frequency depends on the line, time of the day, and day of the week, varying between 2 to 5 minutes in peak hour and 15 minutes on evenings.

MADRID CITY BUSES: EMT

Urban buses operate daily from 6:00 a.m. to 11:45 p.m. Service frequency along a particular route depends on the time of the day and the bus route and may fluctuate between 5 and 8 minutes. From 11:45 p.m. through the whole night, a network of 25 night bus lines comes into operation - these buses are commonly known as "owls". In addition to this, during weekends some night bus routes, called "Metro Buhos", operate while the underground system is closed.


HOW TO GET TO THE NEAREST HOSPITAL

- Follow the signs for Cdad. Sanitaria La Paz and you have to walk 80 meters
